Discover This Month

Banning Museum

Find out how the "Father of Los Angeles Harbor" and his family lived during the days of the U.S. Civil War.

Phinneas Banning was a Union Army general and founder of the harbor at Wilmington who built a beautiful Greek Revival mansion in to demonstrate his confidence that the nation would endure.

And the mansion has endured as a museum in Banning Park. It's open to the public daily for tours. Its rooms are decorated as they were during the Banning family's residence there. The visitor center was once the family's schoolhouse. There's a livery on the grounds that's used as a museum and for special events.

Summer never lasts long enough. Make the most of it with the great family attractions around San Pedro, the LA Harbor and Palos Verdes Peninsula communities, and Catalina Island.

While at **Cabrillo Beach**, don't miss San Pedro's outstanding aquarium. It's a marine research facility that makes things interesting and educational for children and adults alike. The Cabrillo Marine Aquarium offers an extensive regular series of educational activities and programs for all ages and lots of exhibits to see in the 21,000- square foot facility designed by noted architect Frank Gehry. It houses the largest collection of Southern California marine life on display in the world, an outdoor tide pool touch tank, teaching laboratory, auditorium, research lab, and gift shop. And there's a regular series of programs that will interest the whole family.

And **Cabrillo Marine Aquarium** is the epicenter for a Southern California tradition: The Running of the Grunion. That's when little silver fish arrive on the beach to mate. The aquarium has a special program every night the grunion run. It begins at 8 p.m. in the auditorium with an informative presentation. Then it's on to the beach to watch this natural event

Grunion runs (and aquarium programs on it) are: Tuesday, May 7 and Monday, May 20 (closed season) and Wednesday, June 5 and Wednesday, June 19 (open season). In closed season, grunion may not be taken; but in the two open season dates, you can gather grunion with your hands and put them in buckets to take home to fry up and eat. It's all explained during the Cabrillo Marine Aquarium programs.

The **Fanfare Fountain** is a great place for the children to cool off in the daytime and a show for the whole family—especially at night when the lights come on. It's actually two fountains, both with synchronized music and lights, that put on beautiful musical shows. You can't swim in the fountains, but a walkway passes between them that, if you venture through it, you've got a good chance of a drenching, or at least a few sprinkles. Head south on the Waterfront Promenade and you'll find an interactive fountain at 2nd Street that pops right out of the ground and you can get as wet as you want. There's an hour's free parking at the World Cruise Center lot. (\$2 per hour after the first hour, up to a maximum of \$18 per day.)

Old Fire Station 36 Museum is a great museum includes remarkable Los Angeles Fire Department apparatus, artifacts from the San Pedro area, and a store with souvenirs. It's located in what's commonly known as San Pedro City Hall, but it's actually the City of Los Angeles Municipal Building. And it's a building that will look familiar to you from the many films and television episodes that have used it as a backdrop. The museum is open Saturdays from 10 a.m.-3 p.m.

Less than an hour away on fast boats to reach an island of natural beauty, adventure, fun, elegance, history, and charm. Great for a day or a week.

There's no way to be bored on Catalina Island—or getting there. The boat ride of just about an hour is FAST! And you're likely to see sea life on your way, along with a great view of Los Angeles Harbor's Main Channel on the way in and out from San Pedro.

On the Island you'll find everything from shopping to great ecotours, marine life exploration activities—including the famous glass-bottom boat—and even a zip line that's already become famous.



Everyone loves the **Los Angeles Maritime Museum**, located in the former Municipal Ferry Building at the foot of 6th Street at the Waterfront. The museum has great exhibits about the growth of the harbor, an incredible collection of highly detailed professional ship models, and a children's reading area—plus lots more. Open Tuesday through Sunday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Take a short trip to **Wilmington** and you can find remarkable Civil War history.

Do not miss The Banning Museum. It was built in 1864 and has been carefully preserved and restored. The docents will tell you all about life and style in this beautiful Domestic Greek Revival house. It's located in Banning Park.

And just down the street is **Drum Barracks**, the Western outpost of the Union Army during the Civil War. Guided tours available.

Along the rocky shores facing the Catalina Channel you'll discover **Pt. Fermin Lighthouse**, an 1874 Victorian stick style structure. It's been restored to show how lighthouse keepers lived during its history, until its light was turned off in 1941. Located in Pt. Fermin Park at the foot of Gaffey Street.

Note: Follow the warnings on the walls around Pt. Fermin. Do climb over any walls in the area. Sunken City is adjacent. Do not climb over or around fences in this area.

The Marine Mammal Care Center at Fort MacArthur is a hospital for ill, injured, and orphaned marine mammals, such as California sea lions, northern elephant seals, harbor seals, and northern fur seals (like the sea lions seen at right). The animals are treated and when possible released back into the ocean. You'll get to see these great creatures up close (but through a fence) as they progress in their recoveries. Helpful volunteers are on hand to explain the work and answer questions about the animals.

You Can Get Around San Pedro and the Peninsula With Transit Services

Public transit serves all attractions and will take you to LA

Find your way around San Pedro - and all of LA.

There are lots of ways to get around.

The Historic Downtown is within walking distance of the Waterfront or you can take the trolley on weekends.

The Downtown Trolley operates on weekends between the Cruise Terminal, 6th and 7th Streets, and Pacific Avenue, CRAFTED at the Port of Los Angeles, SS Lane Victory, and a stop at Battleship Iowa.

DASH buses operate on routes throughout the greater San Pedro area, south as far as 25th Street and west to Western Avenue.

Commuter Express line 142 has direct service to the Downtown Long Beach Transit Center where you can catch the Blue Line train that travels to downtown Los Angeles and connects to most rail lines that run throughout the greater Los Angeles area. Catch it at Ports O' Call Village or at stops along 7th Street and Gaffey Street north of 7th Street.

Metro Transit buses operate several lines into, out of, and around San Pedro, mainly along 7th Street, Pacific Avenue, and Gaffey Street (although other streets are also served).

- Metro Route 205 runs between the San Pedro Waterfront and Rosa Parks Station
- Metro Route 246 operates between Pt. Fermin and the Harbor Gateway Transit Center
- Metro Route 344 provides service between Palos Verdes Drive South and the Harbor Gateway Transit Center
- Metro Express Route 450 goes from 21 Street and Pacific Avenue to Downtown Los Angeles
- Metro Route 550 operates between Little Company of Mary Hospital (at 7th and Patton Street) and Exposition Park (home to the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, University of Southern California, and many museums)
- Metro Route 910/950X are Silver Line/Silver Line Express buses that operate between Pacific Avenue at 21st Street to the El Monte Station (with stops in Downtown Los Angeles)

Connections to **Metrorail** are available from Downtown Los Angeles's Metro Center and some buses stop at rail stations along their routes.

The Palos Verdes Transit Authority provides bus services around the Palos Verdes Peninsula, to San Pedro, and as far north and west as Redondo Beach




