San Pedro loves the arts and artists. They also love to see their heritage and history preserved. You'll find both at Angels Gate Cultural Center. It's housed in vintage buildings that were formerly a part of Ft. MacArthur, an Army coastal defense base. After the base's upper reservation was turned over to the City of Los Angeles, Angels Gate Park was created. And in that park is the Cultural Center, a set of studios, workshops, galleries, and performance spaces that support artists and their work. There's always an outstanding exhibition, workshops, and performance art going on. This month, on Saturday, August 4 is the opening of Stone's Throw from the Water, an exhibition that runs through September 15. And on Saturday, August 18 is Phogust, a presentation of bent, broken, and appropriated sounds for the discerning listener. Angels Gate Cultural Center is at 3600 S. Gaffey Street.

Art SAI Around San Pedro & the Peninsula

What does a thriving arts community look like? It looks a lot like San Pedro, the Palos Verdes Peninsula, and Catalina Island.

The region has long been a favorite place for artists. And today it's home to galleries, studios, artists' collectives, and other places where art is created, enjoyed, and appreciated, with plenty of events that let the public get up close with art and the artists who create it.







For 82 years now, the San Pedro Art Association has been the standard bearer for local artists.

Its large gallery space at CRAFTED at the Port of Los Angeles is home base for a range of artists. And through this month it's also hosting the Harbor Wide All Grades Student Art Competition and Exhibition, where you can see outstanding works from area students.

The association also has a group exhibition every Friday at the Downtown San Pedro Farmers Market on 6th Street between Pacific Avenue and Mesa Street. And on the First Thursday of every month, its members regularly show their art at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, 601 S. Palos Verdes Street, Downtown.

Drop by and see the member artists at any of their exhibitions. They love to discuss their work. The San Pedro Waterfront Arts District is proof that the area is a great center for the arts. It's been designated as one of 14 Cultural Districts in the state of California. And there's only one other in all of Los Angeles. A Cultural District, as outlined by the program, is a well-defined geographic area with a high concentration of cultural resources and activities.

Downtown San Pedro and its immediate surroundings are home to more than 90 visual artists, as well as restaurants, performing arts venues, and art galleries.

The San Pedro Waterfront Arts District has led the way in making art more accessible by sponsoring public art projects. Currently there are 17 artist-painted city Department of Transportation utility boxes (*pictured above*), three large scale murals, and a vinyl mural on the side of a local sign company's building.

And it has plans for eight more utility boxes, along with two more wall murals. In the fall of 2018, the Arts District will be adding public art to a new fast food restaurant site on Gaffey Street.

Also coming up this fall, the Arts District will present renowned art scholar Gregorio Luke and Quatro@Cabrillo: Arts Adventures for the Culturally Curious Celebrating the Arts of Mexico. The event will be held Sunday, September 16 beginning at 2 p.m. at Cabrillo Marine Aquarium. And three film presentations will follow in the series next year: Gravity (January 27), Birdman (March 24), and The Shape of Water (May 19).

With all the arts going on around town, you'll want to keep up with what's new and current. About the best way to do this is by reading Random Lengths News. Whether

you're looking for visual or performing arts, Random Lengths always has extensive coverage on what's hot.

It's the only locally-produced newspaper, coming out every other Thursday. You can find it at more than 300 locations around the area.

And building on its growing reputation as an important center of the arts, San Pedro hosts the National Watercolor Society and its gallery. The gallery is open during the First Thursday Art Walk each month and has additional hours during special shows, including its National Exhibition in November and December each year.

NWS was founded in 1920 and opened its gallery in Uptown Pacific Avenue in 2010.

You'll find the work of the best watercolor painters in the world—and you won't believe some of these paintings are watercolors with their vivid detail and vibrant colors.

If you want to see a lot of high quality arts and crafts, CRAFTED at the Port of Los Angeles is the place to go.

It's home to the San Pedro Art Association gallery along with vendors ranging from craft foods, jewelry, textiles, cosmetics, and home décor.



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
