You'll Find Adventure Is Just a Boat Ride Away on Catalina

From inland adventures to walking tours, this little bit of paradise just across the channel offers all you could want

Adventure is just a boat ride away to Catalina Island. And don't think that just because you're on an island your choices will be limited.

Catalina's attractions are spread around four distinct regions. From one side of the island to the other you'll find plenty to keep everyone's attention.

Avalon is the city on Catalina Island and it's here you'll find the shopping—and lots more, like the ocean activities and tours.

The 45-minute undersea expedition brings you face-to-face with Catalina's marine life through your own porthole. One of the favorite sightings on this adventure is the giant bright orange California garibaldi fish.

The Glass Bottom Boat originated in the

waters around Catalina Island and are a favorite attraction still. The Catalina Island Company glass bottom boat tour takes visitors to Lover's Cove Marine Preserve to see schools of color fish and other sea creatures.

Looking for something exhilarating? Catalina has that.

Try the 60-minute Ocean Runner on the fast Ribcraft boat. You might even spot some sea lions or dolphins.

Want to go really fast? Jump on the Cyclone Sea Adventure for a 40-minute ride from the Green Pier onto the high seas. Spectacular views of the Catalina shoreline. They call it a "coastal cruise with attitude."

Or explore the adventure inland.

Tours and expeditions range in duration. There's the 50-minute Avalon Canyon Trail tour, where you'll see the Catalina Island Golf Course (oldest in California) and Wrigley Memorial and Botanical Gardens—plus the former spring training site of the Chicago Cubs. And there's the

four-hour 15-minute Cape Canyon Expedition that visits the Middle Ranch habitat of bald and golden eagles, Sheep Chute, Little Harbor, and the Airport in the Sky. Custom biofuel Hummers take you along these routes.

Or choose other inland routes that include a Summit Night Adventure and Skyline Drive, among others.

You could get some exercise, too, by choosing one of the walking tours that include three to the famous Avalon Casino.

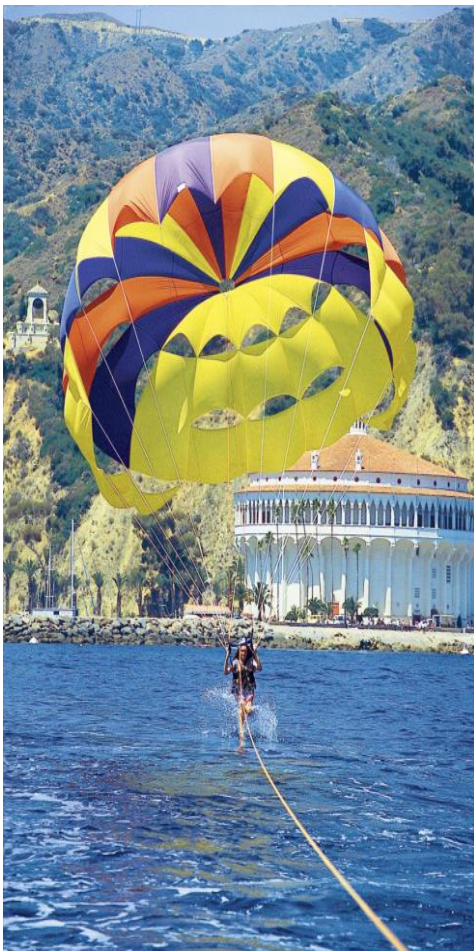

The late Sr. Posada directly influenced artists like Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera, shaped Mexican identity, and continues to inform contemporary image making today. A wide representation of Posada's work, including his famous Day of the Dead Calaveras and the artist's original printing plates, make

up this exhibition. Through April 8.

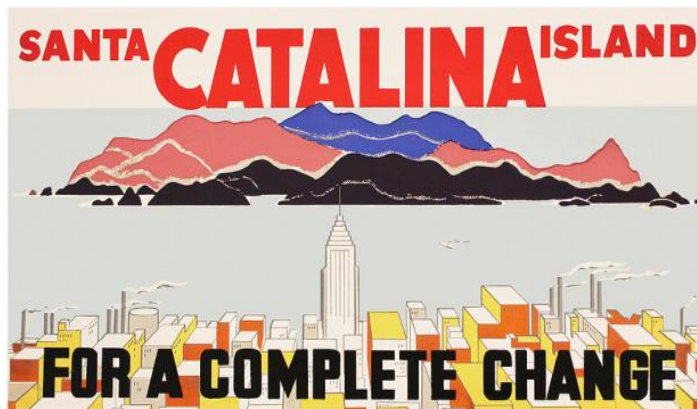

And if you need an excuse to visit the

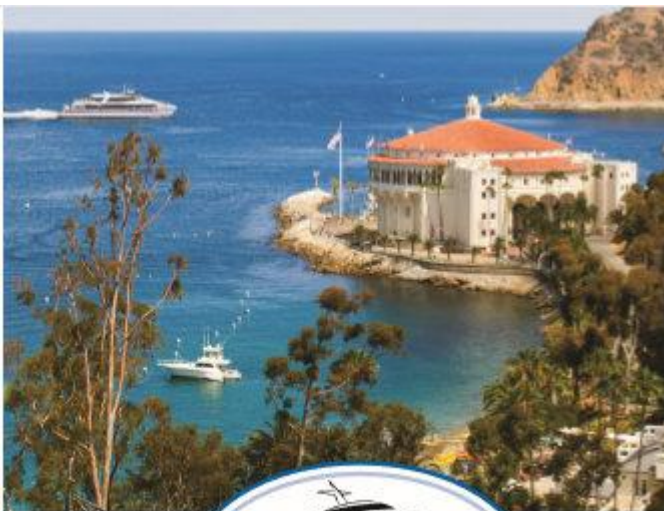
