

Then It's a Good Day to Go Sailing.

The racing season is now in full swing in San Pedro!



And The Harbor Cup, a three-day regatta hosted by Los Angeles Yacht Club, Port of Los Angeles, and California Maritime Academy, is the inspiring cornerstone. It will be held March 9-11.

This race, now in its 10th year is competitive and prestigious. There is an actual Harbor Cup. It's a beautiful perpetual trophy.

Ten co-ed college teams from across the nation and Europe will battle for three days in what has proven to be one of the leading competitions of its kind. College level regattas are typically sailed in small one or two-person dinghies, in protected waters.

But in 2008, Los Angeles Yacht Club and the Port of Los Angeles introduced this rare opportunity for highlevel offshore keelboat racing, with large competitive co-ed teams.

Invitations are highly-coveted and this year's field includes: defending champi-

ons California Maritime Academy, College of Charleston, University of Hawaii, Maine Maritime Academy, Massachusetts Maritime Academy, US Naval Academy, University of California Santa Barbara, University of Southern California, University of South Florida, and Ireland's Cork Institute of Technology.

Teams of eight, including at least two female crew, will race in Catalina 37s – a one-design fleet of sailboats utilized in the prestigious Congressional Cup regatta.

The series will consist of 10 windward-leeward races on the Pacific Ocean course outside Angels' Gate.

Racers will enjoy the hospitality of LAYC: lodging, meals, and special events – including a Saturday night crew and alumni dinner with guest speaker Terry Hutchinson, a champion sailor since his own college years, Hutchinson is a two-time Rolex Yachtsman of the Year.

LAYC was founded in 1901 and is one of oldest and most respected institutions on the West Coast, hosting events such as the Harbor Cup and Transpacific Yacht Race.

And there's lots of other racing going on at the club. The George Griffith Sailing Series continues March 24 and May 12. In

September there's the Catch Me Who Can Coastal Race and the Pacific Coast Championship Mercury Class. And the season wraps up with the Harbor Series Howland's Landing Layover Race.

Howland's Landing is LA Yacht Club's

spot on Catalina Island.

And Buccaneer Yacht Club sponsors or participates in racing nearly every week beginning with its Race Series #1 and followed the fun Games Luck Dinghy

Race, LAYC's George Griffith Series, and other races. This is a yacht club that's very welcoming and where the members are glad to help people learn to sail or improve their skills.

Buccaneer promotes Corinthian Sailing,

which encourages amateur sailing (no paid professional sailors on board), friendship, competition, and fun.

Ask about the Sailing Alliance that undertakes weekly sailing, crewing of captainin and the club's participation in Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club and other clubs' events.

Pt. Fermin Park is a pretty much ideal spot to view many of the yacht races. The park, at the point of the San Pedro peninsula, is set among large trees overlooking the portion of the Pacific Ocean where most racing takes place or passes through.
