What does family fun look like? It looks a lot like San Pedro!

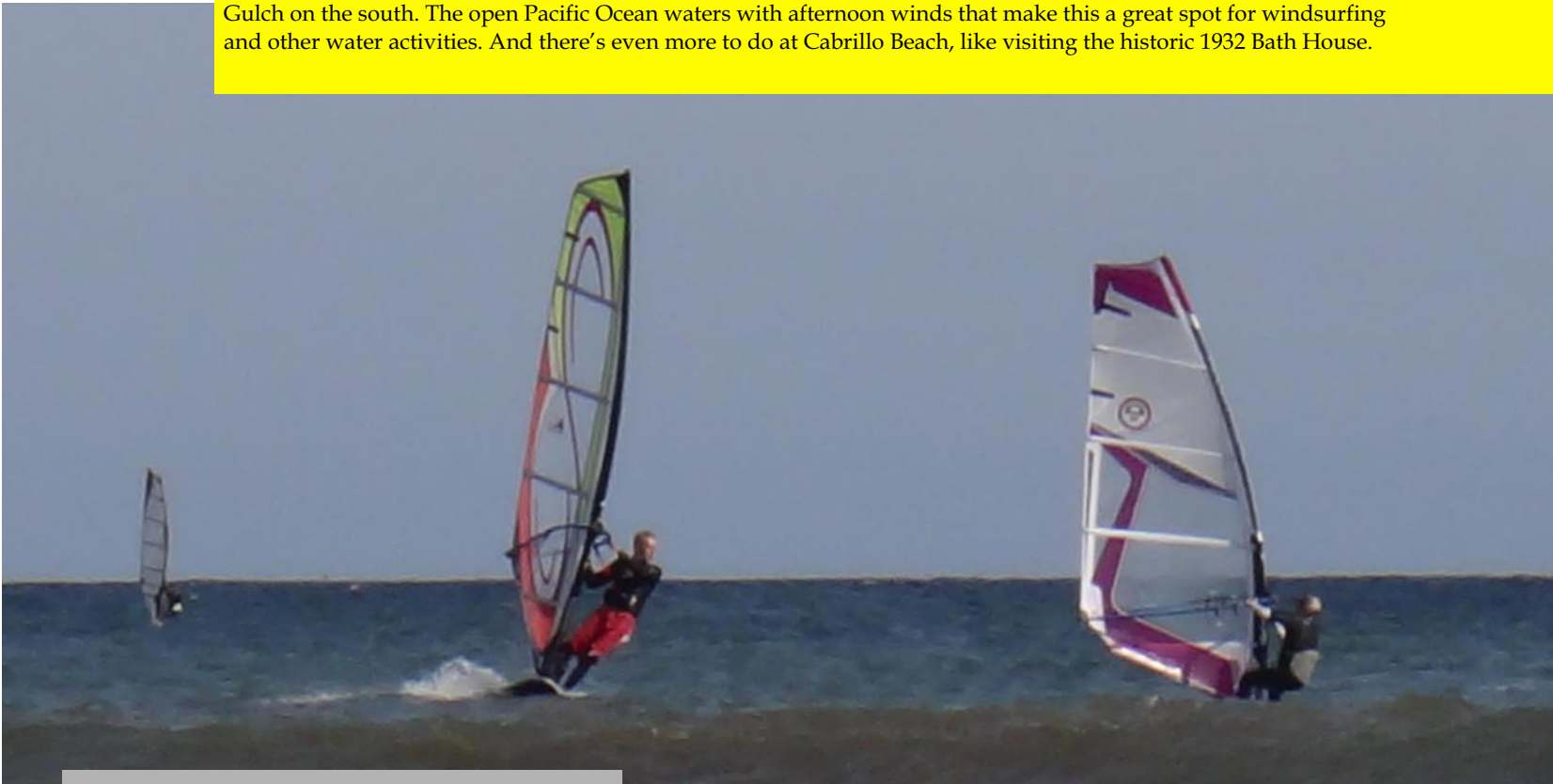
You've got so many choices throughout the region. From San Pedro and the Harbor communities to the Palos Verdes Peninsula communities and Catalina Island you'll find lots to do.

And we've rounded up some of the best so that you've got family fun all summer long.

White Point Nature Education Center is a restored coastal sage scrub habitat. It offers hiking and handicap-accessible trails overlooking the ocean and Catalina Island. And be sure to check the schedule for guided ranger walks and many other expert-led family-friendly activities. Open Wednesdays, Saturdays, and Sundays 10 a.m.- 4 p.m. 1600 W. Paseo Del Mar, Peninsula.

While at Cabrillo Beach, don't miss San Pedro's own well-regarded and very active aquarium and marine research facility. The Cabrillo Marine Aquarium offers an extensive regular series of educational activities and programs for all ages and lots of exhibits to see in the 21,000- square foot facility designed by noted architect Frank Gehry. It houses the largest collection of Southern California marine life on display in the world, an outdoor tide pool touch tank, teaching laboratory, auditorium, research lab, and gift shop.

A good part of a day—or even all day—can be spent at Cabrillo Beach. Calm sandy beach on the north, Hurricane Gulch on the south. The open Pacific Ocean waters with afternoon winds that make this a great spot for windsurfing and other water activities. And there's even more to do at Cabrillo Beach, like visiting the historic 1932 Bath House.



Old Fire Station 36 Museum is a great museum includes remarkable Los Angeles Fire Department apparatus, artifacts from the San Pedro area, and a store with souvenirs. It's located in what's commonly known as San Pedro City Hall, but it's actually the City of Los Angeles Municipal Building. And it's a building that will look familiar to you from the many films and television episodes that have used it as a backdrop. The museum is open Saturdays from 10 a.m.-3 p.m.

The Fanfare Fountain is a great place for the children to cool off in the daytime and a show for the whole family—especially at night when the lights come on. It's actually two fountains, both with synchronized music and lights, that put on beautiful musical shows. You can't swim in the fountains, but a walkway passes between them that, if you venture through it, you've got a good chance of a drenching, or at least a few sprinkles. Take a few steps north, across Swinford Avenue and you'll find a quiet reflecting pool. Head south on the Waterfront Promenade and you'll find an interactive fountain at 2nd Street that pops right out of the ground and you can get as wet as you want. There's an hour's free parking at the World Cruise Center lot.

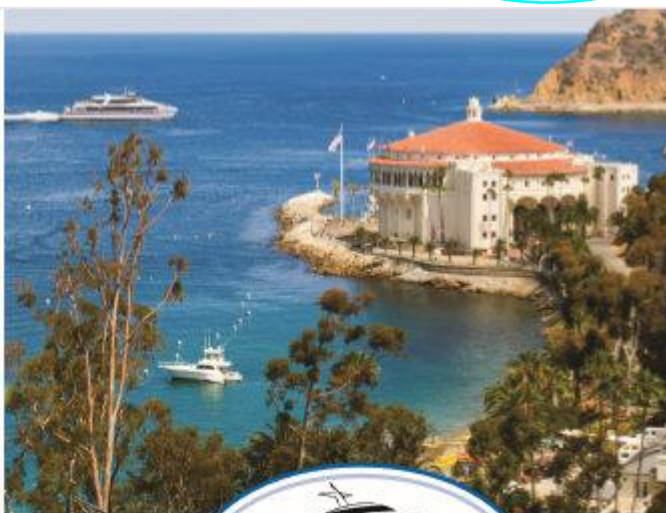
Take a short trip to Wilmington and you'll find yourself back in the Civil War Days.

Do not miss The Banning Residence Museum. It was built in 1864 and has been carefully preserved and restored. The docents will tell you all about life and style in this beautiful Domestic Greek Revival house. It's located in Banning Park. And just down the street is Drum Barracks, the Western outpost of the Union Army during the Civil War. Guided tours available.

Along the rocky shores facing the Catalina Channel you'll discover Pt. Fermin Lighthouse, an 1874 Victorian stick style structure. It's been restored to show how lighthouse keepers lived during its history, until its light was turned off in 1941. Located in Pt. Fermin Park at the foot of Gaffey Street.

Note: Follow the warnings on the walls around Pt. Fermin. Do not climb over any walls in the area. Sunken City is adjacent. Do not climb over or around fences in this area.

Not far from Pt. Fermin

Park—just across Paseo del Mar—is Angels Gate Park, and there you'll find the Marina Mammal Care Center. The center rescues and rehabilitates pinnipeds, such as California sea lions, northern elephant seals, harbor seals, and northern fur seals. The animals are treated and when possible released back into the ocean. You'll get to see these great creatures up close (but through a fence) as they progress in their recoveries. Helpful volunteers are on hand to explain the work and answer questions about the animals.



Ft. MacArthur Museum is located in the corridors (built into the cliffs) of historic Battery Osgood-Farley, from the days when Ft. MacArthur was a coastal defense with big guns. It interprets and preserves history from the days before World War I to the Cold War. Ft. MacArthur Museum is open Tuesdays, Thursdays, weekends, and holidays from 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

Nearby in Angels Gate Park is

the Angels Gate Cultural Center, a wonderful village of artists' studios, galleries, and the vitality of artistic life. The center offers a range of children's art classes, along with some designed especially for children and adults to work together (and we should mention a full range of classes for adults). 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

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
